### Global software conference, Serverless Days, returns for 2023

Serverless Days Belfast, the software community conference focused on the movement of the industry towards serverless and modern cloud technology, will return on 28 February 2023. The one-day event takes place at Game of Thrones Studios in Banbridge, where the speaker panel will include industry leaders such as Lego and Amazon Web Services, alongside local serverless advocates.
